Rescue the poor and helpless; deliver them from the grasp of evil people —Psalm 82:4



Poverty leads many to make desperate choices that result in being trafficked or another form of exploitation. But the good news is God offers freedom and restoration.

Rescue & Restore

Human trafficking and other forms of exploitation exist everywhere people live because they are expressions of our fallen nature. And it's clear that few things grieve God's heart more.

That's why rescuing and restoring the exploited—women, children, and even men—is the heartbeat of Extreme Love Ministries.

We know that's your heart as well, and we're thankful that together we can "rescue the poor and helpless; [and] deliver them from the grasp of evil people" (Psalm 82:4).

You have the power to protect vulnerable children and adults in Cambodia from traffickers, **and the power to rescue and restore** those who have been exploited and abused.

Education

In the 1970s the infamous Khmer Rouge systematically slaughtered almost every teacher in Cambodia. The nation still has yet to recover fully from that horrific trauma and loss.

Families in Cambodia know the tremendous opportunities education can open up for their child and their family, so kids greatly value going to school.

By giving the gift of an education to a child, you can help them break the cycle of poverty, protect them from exploitation, and provide them with hope for a future.

to send a child to school and supply education materials

Education is a treasured opportunity for the poor that can break the cycle of poverty and give kids a hope and a future



Provide a full education sponsorship for one at-risk child (\$120/month)



Share half an education sponsorship for one at-risk child (\$60/month)



Feed lunch to one at-risk child every day during school (\$40/month)



Sponsor a special event for kids (educational outing, sports program, or a learning incentive)

Skill Training

Many women in Cambodia are uneducated and living in poverty, often leading to desperation and exploitation.

Everlasting Love (EL) is a social enterprise and training program that provides a woman fleeing prostitution and human trafficking with immediate job skills and employment making high-end products (bags, shirts, scarves and more) so she can support herself and her family, and help fill her with a sense of worth and value.

If she has children, they are given a safe place to learn and receive care while mom works and trains nearby, thereby breaking the cycle of exploitation for generations to come.

Provide a month of training, employment and empowerment for someone escaping prostitution or human trafficking



Give a month of daycare we provide for the at-risk child of one woman in our Everlasting Love training program

Slum communities in Phnom Penh, Cambodia's capitol city, are very susceptible to flooding from monsoon rains. ELM has established "lighthouses" (rented dwellings where our staff come weekly to minister and build transformative relationships for the kingdom) in many, positioning us to respond quickly to emergency needs.



Relief

When crisis strikes, the poorest men, women and children suffer most. This year's pandemic spread that suffering around the world, deeply impacting those in developing nations. Food shortage and other pressing needs continue for the destitute homeless and those living in Cambodia's slum communities.

Likewise, Northern Iraq's ethnic and religious minorities have been forcibly displaced by ISIS. Villages and cities destroyed. Thousands killed. Thousands more raped, trafficked (sold locally and abroad), and trained as soldiers. Thousands still live in camps.

Help meet physical needs (food, clothing, basic care), and restore identity and hope to the abused and tortured.

[My family was] poor, and I had to make money for myself, so...I worked as a waitress, but I met one man there. He told me "I love you," and I believed him. We had sex together one time, then I never saw him again.

I got pregnant, and...I called the man...he replied, "I am not responsible." I was so broken. I wanted to kill myself. I felt so much shame, I was so embarrassed.

I got...tuberculosis and wasn't able to work in the bar anymore. I felt hopeless...so I had an abortion. It hurt so bad. I wanted to keep it but thought I had no other choice. I cry thinking about the choices I have made in my life...

Now I have new opportunities for work. I am sewing, and I love what I am doing! I am happy again. God gave me joy, and he will give you joy, as well.
